The Purdue Union is on the corner of State and Grant Streets in West Lafayette. State Street is Indiana Route 26, and connects West Lafayette with Lafayette. Access from the William H. Harrison Bridge may be had by proceeding south on North Grant Street. The Purdue Memorial Center is the building immediately west of the Union. Parking is an impossible problem, but there is a lot behind the Union. A city lot is one block east of Grant, off State Street. All-day parking is available in the rear of that lot for 25¢.
